WHAT IT IS

The Toolkit is intended to assess three important components of an organization or system:

- People (that reflect an organization's diversity)
- Processes (that demonstrate an organization's culture of inclusion)
- Power (structures that show how an organization makes decisions that lead to greater equity)

WHO CAN BENEFIT

No matter where an organization is on the Diversity, Equity & Inclusion spectrum, the Toolkit can give crucial information about its people, processes and power structures.

How an organization reflects the community it serves is never "one size fits all." Instead, knowing the community and how it operates—and then reflecting that in an authentic way—is what matters to being effective and accountable.

HOW IT WORKS

Organizations and businesses should use this online assessment to:

- Understand their own internal diversity as compared to the community they serve
- To set goals that create internal and external equity and inclusion and clarify roles and responsibilities that move the organization toward them
- To commit to organizational priorities that maintain and enhance diversity, equity and inclusion
